- AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to including scores for international baccalaureate examinations as eligible criteria for receiving a New York state achievement and investment in merit scholarship

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Paragraph b of subdivision 2 of section 669-g of the educa-2 tion law, as added by section 1 of part Z of chapter 56 of the laws of 3 2015, is amended to read as follows:

4 graduated with a "with honors" distinction on a New York state b. 5 regents diploma [or], received a score of 3 or higher on two or more 6 advanced placement examinations, RECEIVED A SCORE OF 3 OR HIGHER ON ONE INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE HIGHER LEVEL 7 MORE OR EXAMINATIONS, OR 8 SCORE OF 4 OF HIGHER ON ONE OR MORE INTERNATIONAL BACCALAU-RECEIVED A 9 REATE STANDARD LEVEL EXAMINATIONS; or

10 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
