AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to requiring any
person operating an aircraft to submit to a breathalyzer

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY,
DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The general business law is amended by adding a new section
2 241-a to read as follows:
3 S 241-A. BREATHALYZER REQUIREMENT. ANY PERSON ENGAGING WITHIN THIS
4 STATE IN OPERATING AIRCRAFT SHALL BE REQUIRED TO SUBMIT TO A BREATHALYZER
5 EXAM PRIOR TO OPERATING SUCH AIRCRAFT. SUCH BREATHALYZER EXAM SHALL
6 OCCUR PRIOR TO SUCH INDIVIDUAL BOARDING THE AIRCRAFT. ANY INDIVIDUAL
7 THAT PROVIDES A BREATH SAMPLE OF .08 OF ONE PER CENTUM OR MORE BY WEIGHT
8 OF ALCOHOL IN THE PERSON'S BLOOD SHALL NOT BE PERMITTED TO OPERATE SUCH
9 AIRCRAFT.
10 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
