AN ACT authorizing the Congregation Lubavitch-Chabad House of Huntington Township, Inc. to receive retroactive real property tax exempt status

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary,  
2     the assessor of the town of Huntington is hereby authorized to accept  
3     from the Congregation Lubavitch-Chabad House of Huntington Township,  
4     Inc. an application for exemption from real property taxes pursuant to  
5     section 420-a of the real property tax law for the 2012-2013, 2013-2014,  
6     and 2014-2015 assessment rolls, for the parcel conveyed to such organ-  
7     ization, with such parcel being located in the hamlet of Melville, 498  
8     Sweet Hollow Road, otherwise known as Suffolk County Tax Map Number  
9     0400.25600.0 100.01 2000.0000. If accepted, the application shall be  
10    reviewed as if it had been received on or before the taxable status date  
11    established for such rolls.

12    If satisfied that such organization would otherwise be entitled to  
13    such exemption if such organization had filed an application for  
14    exemption by the appropriate taxable status dates, the assessor of the  
15    town of Huntington upon approval by the governing body or the tax  
16    department, may grant exemption from all taxation beginning on the date  
17    of the conveyance of such parcel to such organization on the effective  
18    date of this act and cancel taxes, fines, penalties, and interest paid  
19    by such organization, and make appropriate correction of the subject  
20    rolls.

21    S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
