THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, 1 the assessor of the town of Huntington is hereby authorized to accept 2 3 from the Congregation Lubavitch-Chabad House of Huntington Township, Inc. an application for exemption from real property taxes pursuant to 4 5 section 420-a of the real property tax law for the 2012-2013 assessment roll for the parcel conveyed to such organization, with such parcel being located in the hamlet of Melville, 498 Sweet Hollow Road, other-6 7 8 wise known as Suffolk County Tax Map Number 0400.25600.0 100.01 9 If accepted, the application shall be reviewed as if it had 2000.0000. been received on or before the taxable status date established for such 10 11 roll.

If 12 satisfied that such organization would otherwise be entitled to 13 such exemption if such organization had filed an application for exemption by the appropriate taxable status dates, the assessor of the 14 town of Huntington upon approval by the governing body or the tax 15 16 department, may grant exemption from all taxation beginning on the date 17 of the conveyance of such parcel to such organization on the effective date of this act and cancel taxes, fines, penalties, and interest paid 18 19 by such organization, and make appropriate correction of the subject 20 rolls.

21 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
