AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to the salary of certain teachers providing instruction in career and technical education to school age students

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Paragraph b of subdivision 5 of section 1950 of the education law, as amended by section 80-a of part A of chapter 58 of the laws of 2011, is amended to read as follows:

b. The cost of services herein referred to shall be the amount allo-5 cated to each component school district by the board of cooperative educational services to defray expenses of such board, except that part of the salary paid any teacher, supervisor or other employee of the 8 board of cooperative educational services which is in excess of thirty 9 thousand dollars shall not be such an approved expense, and except 10 administrative and clerical expenses shall not exceed ten percent of the total expenses for purposes of this computation. PROVIDED HOWEV-11 ER, THAT FOR TEACHERS PROVIDING INSTRUCTION IN CAREER AND TECHNICAL 12 13 EDUCATION TO SCHOOL AGE STUDENTS, THE SALARY, TO BE CONSIDERED AS AN APPROVED EXPENSE, SHALL NOT EXCEED THIRTY-FOUR THOUSAND DOLLARS FOR 14 15 THOUSAND SIXTEEN--TWO THOUSAND SEVENTEEN SCHOOL YEAR; THIRTY-EIGHT THOUSAND DOLLARS FOR THE TWO THOUSAND SEVENTEEN--TWO 16 THOUSAND EIGHTEEN 17 SCHOOL YEAR; FORTY-TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS FOR THE TWO THOUSAND 18 EIGHTEEN--TWO THOUSAND NINETEEN SCHOOL YEAR; FORTY-SIX THOUSAND DOLLARS 19 THE TWO THOUSAND NINETEEN--TWO THOUSAND TWENTY SCHOOL YEAR; AND 20 FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS FOR THE TWO THOUSAND TWENTY--TWO THOUSAND 21 TY-ONE SCHOOL YEAR, AND THEREAFTER. Any gifts, donations or interest earned by the board of cooperative educational services or on behalf of 22 the board of cooperative educational services by the dormitory authority 23 24 any other source shall not be deducted in determining the cost of services allocated to each component school district. Any payments made 26 a component school district by the board of cooperative educational services pursuant to subdivision eleven of section six-p of the general 27

municipal law attributable to an approved cost of service computed pursuant to this subdivision shall be deducted from the cost of services allocated to such component school district. The expense of transportation provided by the board of cooperative educational services pursuant to paragraph q of subdivision four of this section shall be eligible for 5 6 aid apportioned pursuant to subdivision seven of section thirty-six hundred two of this chapter and no board of cooperative educational 7 8 services transportation expense shall be an approved cost of services for the computation of aid under this subdivision. Transportation 9 10 expense pursuant to paragraph q of subdivision four of this section shall be included in the computation of the ten percent limitation on 11 administrative and clerical expenses. 12

S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
