AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to creating new degree or certificate programs at community colleges in order to increase successful job placement for future students

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 6303 of the education law is amended by adding a 2 new subdivision 6 to read as follows:
- 6. THE BOARDS OF TRUSTEES OF THE STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK COMMUNI-TY COLLEGES SHALL CONSULT WITH THE REGIONAL COMMUNITY COLLEGE COUNCILS 5 ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO CHAPTER FIFTY OF THE LAWS OF TWOTHOUSAND 6 SIXTEEN TO CREATE NEW DEGREE OR CERTIFICATE PROGRAMS OR RESTRUCTURE CURRENT PROGRAMS IN ORDER TO INCREASE SUCCESSFUL JOB PLACEMENT 8 STUDENTS. THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE COUNCILS SHALL USE FUTURE REGIONAL 9 DEPARTMENT OF LABOR DATA THAT PREDICTS FUTURE WORKFORCE NEEDS 10 CONSULT WITH REGIONAL BUSINESSES TO MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE BOARDS OF TRUSTEES ON HOW NEW PROGRAMS SHOULD BE 11 STRUCTURED OR ON WAYS CURRENT PROGRAMS TO TAILOR SUCH PROGRAMS TO INDUSTRY NEEDS. 12 RESTRUCTURE 13 FOR EACH STUDENT WHO SUCCESSFULLY OBTAINS EMPLOYMENT UPON GRADUATING FROM A NEWLY CREATED OR RESTRUCTURED PROGRAM OR UPON RECEIVING A CERTIF-14 15 ICATE, THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE SHALL BE REIMBURSED UP TO FIFTY PERCENT OF THE COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH EDUCATING SUCH STUDENT, PURSUANT TO 16 ATION. IF A COMMUNITY COLLEGE FAILS TO COMPLY WITH THE PROVISIONS OF 17 18 THIS SUBDIVISION, SUCH COLLEGE MAY BE SUBJECT TO A REDUCTION 19 FUNDING.
- 20 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately; provided, however, that 21 no community college shall lose state funding for failing to comply with 22 this act until after July 1, 2020.
