AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to policies that allow students with disabilities to participate in a high school graduation ceremony

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Short title. This act shall be known and may be cited as 2 "Zachary's Law".
 - S 2. Section 4402 of the education law is amended by adding a new subdivision 9 to read as follows:
- 5 9. THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OR THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF EACH SCHOOL 6 DISTRICT THAT OPERATES A HIGH SCHOOL SHALL ESTABLISH A POLICY AND ADOPT 7 PROCEDURES TO ALLOW ANY STUDENT WITH A DISABILITY IN SUCH DISTRICT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE GRADUATION CEREMONY OF THE STUDENT'S HIGH SCHOOL 8 9 GRADUATING CLASS AND ALL RELATED ACTIVITIES IF SUCH STUDENT HAS BEEN 10 ISSUED A SKILLS AND ACHIEVEMENT COMMENCEMENT CREDENTIAL BUT OTHERWISE QUALIFIED FOR A REGENTS OR LOCAL HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA. 11 STUDENT SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IF THE STUDENT'S INDIVIDUALIZED 12 13 EDUCATION PROGRAM PRESCRIBES SPECIAL EDUCATION, TRANSITION PLANNING, TRANSITION SERVICES, OR RELATED SERVICES BEYOND THE STUDENT'S FOUR 14 15 ACADEMIC YEARS AFTER THE STUDENT'S ENTRY INTO HIGH SCHOOL. THEPOLICY PROCEDURES SHALL PROVIDE ANNUAL WRITTEN NOTICE TO ALL STUDENTS WITH 16 DISABILITIES AND THEIR PARENTS OR GUARDIANS ABOUT THE SCHOOL DISTRICT'S 17 18 POLICY AND PROCEDURES ADOPTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SUBDIVISION. NOTH-19 IN THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL COMPEL A STUDENT WITH DISABILITIES TO 20 PARTICIPATE IN THE HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION CEREMONY AND ACTIVITIES. THE 21 SUPERINTENDENT SHALL CONSIDER THE RECOMMENDATION, IF ANY, STUDENT'S COMMITTEE ON SPECIAL EDUCATION AS WELL AS THE 22 STUDENT'S
- 23 EXPRESSED PREFERENCE. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SUBDIVISION, A STUDENT'S HIGH
- 24 SCHOOL GRADUATING CLASS SHALL BE THE TWELFTH GRADE CLASS WITH WHICH SUCH
- 25 STUDENT WITH A DISABILITY ENTERED INTO NINTH GRADE.
- 26 S 3. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 27 have become a law.
