AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to enacting "Jacobe's law"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as "Jacobe's law." S 2. The education law is amended by adding a new section 15-a to read 3 as follows:
- 15-A. REPORTING BY SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS. 1. SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS, 5 AS DEFINED BY SUBDIVISION SIX OF SECTION ELEVEN HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE OF 6 TITLE, SHALL MAKE A GOOD FAITH EFFORT TO CONTACT THE PARENT OR 7 GUARDIAN OF A STUDENT IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING A REPORT OF BULLYING HARASSMENT OR A REASONABLE CAUSE TO SUSPECT AN INCIDENT OF BULLYING OR 9 HARASSMENT OF THE STUDENT. "HARASSMENT" AND "BULLYING" SHALL 10 AND BULLYING AS DEFINED UNDER SUBDIVISION SEVEN OF SECTION HARASSMENT
- 11 ELEVEN OF THIS ARTICLE.
- 2. THE SCHOOL ADMINISTRATOR SHALL CONTACT THE PARENT OR GUARDIAN BY 12 TELEPHONE, ELECTRONIC MAIL, REGULAR MAIL OR OTHER MEANS. 13
- 14 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
