AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the pensionable earnings of first grade police officers

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 14-111 of the administrative code of the city of 2 New York is amended by adding two new subdivisions c and d to read as 3 follows:
 - C. WHEN A FIRST GRADE POLICE OFFICER SHALL HAVE SERVED IN THE RANK OF POLICE OFFICER FOR A PERIOD OF TWENTY-FIVE YEARS, HE OR SHE SHALL HAVE THE SAME RIGHTS IN RESPECT TO THE POLICE PENSION FUND AS A POLICE OFFICER DESIGNATED TO ACT AS DETECTIVE OF THE THIRD GRADE WHO SHALL HAVE SERVED AS SUCH FOR A PERIOD OF TIME AGGREGATING TWO YEARS AT THE HIGHEST SALARY RATE FOR A DETECTIVE OF THE THIRD GRADE.
- D. WHEN A FIRST GRADE POLICE OFFICER SHALL HAVE SERVED IN THE RANK OF POLICE OFFICER FOR A PERIOD OF THIRTY YEARS, HE OR SHE SHALL HAVE THE SAME RIGHTS IN RESPECT TO THE POLICE PENSION FUND AS A SERGEANT WHO SHALL HAVE SERVED AS SUCH FOR A PERIOD OF TIME AGGREGATING TWO YEARS AT
- 15 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
