AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to prohibiting certain devices which enhance a vehicle's capacity to emit soot, smoke or other particulate emissions

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 375 of the vehicle and traffic law 2 is amended by adding a new paragraph (f) to read as follows:
- 3 (F) NO PERSON SHALL RETROFIT ANY DIESEL-POWERED VEHICLE WITH ANY 4 DEVICE, SMOKE STACK, OR OTHER EQUIPMENT WHICH ENHANCES THE VEHICLE'S 5 CAPACITY TO EMIT SOOT, SMOKE, OR OTHER PARTICULATE EMISSIONS, OR SHALL 6 PURPOSELY RELEASE SIGNIFICANT QUANTITIES OF SOOT, SMOKE, OR OTHER PARTICULATE EMISSIONS INTO THE AIR AND ONTO ROADWAYS AND OTHER VEHICLES WHILE 7 CULATE EMISSIONS INTO THE AIR AND ONTO ROADWAYS AND OTHER VEHICLES WHILE 8 OPERATING THE VEHICLE. ANY SUCH VIOLATION SHALL BE PUNISHABLE AS A 9 MISDEMEANOR.
- 10 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
