AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to observance of certain holidays by institutions within the state university and the city university of New York

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 362 to read as follows: 2
- 362. HOLIDAYS TO BE OBSERVED. NO CLASS OR ANY OTHER COURSE OF INSTRUCTION SHALL BE HELD IN ANY INSTITUTION WITHIN THE STATE UNIVERSITY ON THOSE DAYS OF RELIGIOUS OBSERVANCE KNOWN AS EID UL-FITR AND PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THE UL-ADHA, THATCHANCELLOR, IN HIS HER OR 7 DISCRETION, MAY EXEMPT ANY INSTITUTION FROM THE FOREGOING PROVISIONS THIS SECTION.
- 9 S 2. The education law is amended by adding a new section 6235 to read 10 as follows:
- 6235. HOLIDAYS TO BE OBSERVED. NO CLASS OR ANY OTHER COURSE OF 11 12 INSTRUCTION SHALL BE HELD IN ANY INSTITUTION WITHIN THE CITY
- 13 THOSE DAYS OF RELIGIOUS OBSERVANCE KNOWN AS EID UL-FITR AND EID
- UL-ADHA PROVIDED, HOWEVER, IN HIS 14 THAT THE CHANCELLOR, OR
- 15 DISCRETION, MAY EXEMPT ANY INSTITUTION FROM THE FOREGOING PROVISIONS OF
- 16 THIS SECTION.
