AN ACT to amend the uniform justice court act, in relation to the location of holding town court proceedings of the town of Canandaigua

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 106 of the uniform justice court act is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision 11 to read as follows:

11. Notwithstanding the provisions of subdivision one of this section, 4 the town of Canandaigua, in the county of Ontario, may hold all town 5 court proceedings in the city of Canandaigua, provided that such 6 proceedings are held in a courtroom or other suitable facility open to 7 the public and the town board of Canandaigua has authorized such extraterritorial proceedings.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
