AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to enacting the "come home to hunt act"

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Short title. This act shall be known and may be cited as 2 the "come home to hunt act".

3 § 2. Section 11-0701 of the environmental conservation law is amended 4 by adding a new subdivision 10 to read as follows:

5 <u>10. A two-day non-resident hunting license entitles a non-resident</u> 6 <u>holder to hunt domestic game bird, migratory game bird, big game, and</u> 7 <u>small game, as provided in title nine of this article, for the two</u> 8 <u>consecutive days specified by such license.</u>

9 § 3. Paragraph b of subdivision 3 of section 11-0715 of the environ-10 mental conservation law is amended by adding a new subparagraph 9 to 11 read as follows:

12 (9) Two-day non-resident hunting license \$40.00

13 § 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
