AN ACT in relation to authorizing the West Babylon Church of God of Prophecy Inc., to file an application for exemption from real property taxes for certain assessment rolls

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, 2 the assessor of the town of Babylon, county of Suffolk, is hereby authorized to accept from the West Babylon Church of God of Prophecy Inc., a not-for-profit corporation, an application for exemption from real property taxes pursuant to section 420-a of the real property tax law with respect to the 2017-2018 assessment rolls, for the parcel owned by such not-for-profit corporation which is located at 196 Little East Neck Road, West Babylon, town of Babylon, county of Suffolk, otherwise known as Suffolk county tax map district 0100, section 216.00, block 10 04.00, lot 026.000. If accepted, the application shall be reviewed as if 11 it had been received on or before the taxable status date established 12 for such assessment rolls.

If satisfied that such corporation would otherwise be entitled to such 14 exemption if such corporation had filed an application for exemption by the appropriate taxable status date, the assessor, upon approval of the Town of Babylon town board, may grant exemption from taxation on such 16 assessment rolls and make the appropriate corrections of the subject 17 rolls. If exemptions are granted and such corporation, therefore, shall 18 19 have paid any tax with respect to the subject rolls, the applicable 20 governing body or tax departments, in their sole discretion, shall 21 provide for the refund of the taxes paid, along with any fines or penalties paid, and cancel taxes remaining unpaid.

23 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
