AN ACT to amend the state finance law, in relation to requiring that certain contracts let by the office of general services be reserved for small businesses, including minority-owned business enterprises and women-owned business enterprises

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 139-g of the state finance law is amended by adding
2 a new subdivision (e) to read as follows:

3 (e) require that multi-year centralized contracts let by the office of
4 general services with a total value of five million dollars or less be
5 reserved for small businesses as defined in section one hundred thirty-
6 one of the economic development law, including minority-owned business
7 enterprises and women-owned business enterprises as defined in section
8 three hundred ten of the executive law.

9 § 2. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall
10 have become a law.
