AN ACT to amend chapter 381 of the laws of 2012, amending the education law relating to the licensure of private proprietary schools, in relation to the effectiveness thereof

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 12 of chapter 381 of the laws of 2012, amending the
2 education law relating to the licensure of private proprietary schools,
3 as amended by chapter 120 of the laws of 2015, is amended to read as
4 follows:
5 § 12. This act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth day
6 after it shall have become a law; provided, however, that subparagraph
7 (iv) of paragraph b of subdivision 4 of section 5001 of the education
8 law, as added by section three of this act, shall expire and be deemed
9 repealed [~~six~~] nine years after such effective date; and provided,
10 further, that paragraph g of subdivision 10 of section 5007 of the
11 education law, as amended by section eight of this act shall not affect
12 the repeal of such paragraph and shall be deemed repealed therewith; and
13 provided, further, that effective immediately, the commissioner of
14 education is authorized and directed to promulgate any regulations need-
15 ed to implement the provisions of this act on such effective date.
16 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
