AN ACT to amend the general municipal law, in relation to the insurance reserve funds of the Niskayuna central school district

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 2 of section 6-n of the general municipal law, as separately amended by chapters 414 and 416 of the laws of 2016, is amended to read as follows:

(a) The governing board of any municipal corporation may establish a 5 reserve fund to be known as the insurance reserve fund. Upon the 6 creation of the fund, the municipality may make expenditures from the 7 fund for any loss, claim, action or judgment for which the municipal corporation is authorized or required to purchase or maintain insurance, except those kinds of risks for which insurance is authorized pursuant 9 10 to paragraph one, two, three, fifteen, sixteen, seventeen, eighteen, twenty-two or twenty-three of subsection (a) of section one thousand one 11 12 hundred thirteen of the insurance law, or for payments in lieu of 13 contributions under article eighteen of the labor law; provided however, 14 that no municipality shall make an expenditure from such fund for any 15 loss, claim, action or judgment for which the municipal corporation has 16 established a reserve fund under any other provision of law; provided, 17 further that the Scarsdale union free school district and the Vernon 18 Verona Sherrill central school district may establish insurance reserve funds in compliance with this section and article seventy-four of the 19 education law and the Minisink Valley central school district may estab-20 lish insurance reserve funds in compliance with this section and article 21 seventy-four of the education law and the Niskayuna central school 22 23 district may establish insurance reserve funds in compliance with this 24 <u>section and article seventy-four of the education law</u> and such school districts may make expenditures in compliance with this section and 25 26 article seventy-four of the education law from such reserve fund for any loss, claim, action or judgment for which the school districts are 27 28 authorized or required to purchase or maintain insurance for the kinds
