AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to the Purple Heart Highway

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 342-x of the highway law, as amended by chapter 49 of the laws of 1992, is amended to read as follows:

§ 342-x. Portion of the state highway system to be designated as the "Purple Heart Highway". That portion of the state highway system constituting [Route 5 excepting therefrom that portion of such route heretofore designated as the "Seaway Trail"] state route five shall hereafter be designated and known as the "Purple Heart Highway".

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
