AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to including removal or threat of removal of religious clothing as aggravated harassment in the second degree

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 3 of section 240.30 of the penal law, as 2 amended by chapter 188 of the laws of 2014, is amended to read as 3 follows:
- 3 TOTIOWS:
 4 3. With the intent to harass, annoy, threaten or alarm another person,
 5 he or she strikes, shoves, kicks, or otherwise subjects another person
- 6 to physical contact, <u>including removing a religious clothing article</u> or
- 7 <u>headdress from such person</u>, or attempts or threatens to do the same
- 8 because of a belief or perception regarding such person's race, color,
- 9 national origin, ancestry, gender, religion, religious practice, age,
- 10 disability or sexual orientation, regardless of whether the belief or
- 11 perception is correct; or
- 12 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
