AN ACT to amend the state finance law, in relation to prohibiting the transfer of unexpended moneys from funds receiving moneys from a dedicated fee into any other fund

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The state finance law is amended by adding a new section 2 73-a to read as follows:
- § 73-a. Transfer of funds. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, unexpended moneys in any fund that:
 - 1. receives revenues from a dedicated fee;

- 6 2. provides that moneys in the fund shall be kept separate from and
 7 shall not be commingled with other moneys in the custody of the comp8 troller; and
- 9 <u>3. provides that moneys in the fund shall be expended only for the 10 purpose designated in the fund</u>
- 11 shall not be transferred to any other fund or account or used for any
- 12 purpose other than that designated by the fund.
- 13 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
