AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to the legislature's power over the board of regents

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 215-a of the education law is amended by adding a 2 new subdivision 3 to read as follows:

3. The annual report required pursuant to subdivision one of this 4 section shall include a statement setting forth the total expenditures 5 made by each school district and boards of cooperative educational services for English Language Learners, in complying with mandates contained in part 154 of the regulations of the commissioner. Such statement shall indicate: (a) the amount of such expenditures covered by state aid; (b) the amount of such expenditures covered by federal aid; (c) the amount of such expenditures not covered by either state or federal aid; and (d) to the extent possible, any year to year increase 11 or decrease in expenditures not covered by either state or federal aid 13 which resulted from the adoption of the amendments to part 154 of the 14 regulations of the commissioner, as acted upon by the board of regents 15 <u>in two thousand fourteen.</u>

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
