- AN ACT to amend the tax law, in relation to granting a sales and compensating use tax exemption for goods sold at school book fairs

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision (a) of section 1115 of the tax law is amended by adding a new paragraph 44 to read as follows: (44) Books, magazines, pamphlets and other school or library book fair related items including, but not limited to, science project kits and posters, sold in a primary or secondary school facility at a school book fair sponsored by a parent-teacher association or organization, booster club, or similar school-based association which supports school activities or sold at a book fair sponsored by library friends or foundation. § 2. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeeding the date on which it shall have become a law.
