AN ACT to amend the military law, in relation to the service credit time of military personnel  $\ensuremath{\mathsf{N}}$ 

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The military law is amended by adding a new section 244-b 2 to read as follows:
- § 244-b. Pension credit during active duty. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, any person, who is a member of any public retirement system of the state, called up for active duty service as a member of the:
- 7 <u>a. Naval militia;</u>
- 8 b. New York state guard;
- 9 <u>c. New York national quard;</u>
- 10 d. Reserves; or
- 11 e. United States Army, Navy, Marines, Air Force, or Coast Guard;
- 12 during any period from September eleventh, two thousand one to the pres-
- 13 ent time, shall be awarded full pension credit, for all time so employed
- 14 on active duty, as if such person was employed full time in their public
- 15 employment, during the time of such active duty service, regardless of
- 16 whether such person receives any wages or salary income from such public
- 17 employment during such active duty service.
- 18 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
