AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to removing the requirement of a sworn statement administered by a notary public for purposes of petitions

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 3 of section 6-132 of the election law, as
2 amended by chapter 447 of the laws of 2006, is amended to read as
3 follows:

4 3. In lieu of the signed statement of a witness who is a duly quali-
5 fied voter of the state qualified to sign the petition, the following
6 statement signed by a notary public or commissioner of deeds shall be
7 accepted:
