AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to clearly marking certain pedestrian crosswalks in any city having a population of one million or more persons

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The administrative code of the city of New York is amended by adding a new section 19-112.1 to read as follows:

§ 19-112.1 Marking certain pedestrian crosswalks and ramps. All pedestrian crosswalks and ramps, not located at street intersections, shall be clearly marked and painted. This provision shall apply to both new and reconstructed crosswalks and ramps.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
