AN ACT to amend the public officers law, in relation to freedom of information requests and attorney's fees

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph (c) of subdivision 4 of section 89 of the public officers law, as amended by chapter 492 of the laws of 2006, is amended to read as follows:

- (c) The court in such a proceeding: (i) may assess, against such agency involved, reasonable attorney's fees and other litigation costs reasonably incurred by such person in any case under the provisions of this section in which such person has substantially prevailed, [when:
  - i. the agency had no reasonable basis for denying access; or
- 9 <u>ii.</u>] <u>and when</u> the agency failed to respond to a request or appeal
  10 within the statutory time; <u>and (ii) shall assess, against such agency</u>
  11 <u>involved, reasonable attorney's fees and other litigation costs reason-</u>
  12 <u>ably incurred by such person in any case under the provisions of this</u>
  13 <u>section in which such person has substantially prevailed and the court</u>
  14 <u>finds that the agency had no reasonable basis for denying access</u>.
  - § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
