AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to establishing the crime of terrorism recruitment, a class C felony

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 490.60 to 2 read as follows:
- 3 § 490.60 Terrorism recruitment.
- A person is guilty of terrorism recruitment when, with intent that
 another person engage in conduct constituting any crime set forth in
 this article, he or she recruits, solicits, requests, commands, importunes or otherwise attempts to cause such other person to engage in such
- 8 conduct.
- 9 <u>Terrorism recruitment is a class C felony.</u>
- 10 § 2. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeed-11 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
