AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to authorizing blood transfusions without a nurse under certain circumstances

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 5 of section 3121 of the public health law, as 2 added by chapter 914 of the laws of 1973, is amended to read as follows: 5. The council shall have power by the affirmative vote of a majority 3 4 of its members to enact, and from time to time, amend and repeal, rules regulations establishing minimum standards for the proper collection, processing, fractionation, storage, distribution, and supply 7 of human blood or blood derivatives, for the purpose of transfusions, subject to approval by the commissioner. Such regulations shall allow 9 for advanced emergency medical technicians to administer blood trans-10 fusions without the presence of a physician, registered nurse, physician 11 assistant, nurse practitioner, licensed practical nurse, or board-certi-12 fied cardiovascular perfusionist on an emergency basis during the trans-13 port to the hospital.

14 § 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after 15 it shall have become a law. Effective immediately, the council on human 16 blood and transfusion services may promulgate any rule or regulation 17 necessary for timely implementation of this act on its effective date.
