AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to the crime of display of sexual material in a vehicle

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 245.12 to read as follows:

§ 245.12 Display of sexual material in a vehicle.

1. A person is guilty of display of sexual material in a vehicle when he or she is in a vehicle that is located in a public place and a sexually explicit video is being displayed on a video or television screen located within that vehicle that is capable of being seen by a person who is not located within the vehicle.

2. The crime of display of sexual material in a vehicle shall be punishable by up to two thousand hours of community service.

3. Any person convicted of the crime of display of sexual material in a vehicle shall, in addition to any community service required to be performed, have one point added to his or her driving record.

Display of sexual material in a vehicle is a violation.

§ 2. The commissioner of motor vehicles is authorized and directed to implement and/or amend any rule or regulation necessary for the timely implementation of this act on its effective date.

§ 3. This act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth day after it shall have become a law.
