AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to requiring teachers colleges to incorporate a course of instruction in mental health

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 305 of the education law is amended by adding a new 2 subdivision 56 to read as follows:
- 56. The commissioner shall establish and enforce rules and regulations requiring every college for teachers or teachers college within the state to incorporate instruction in mental health within current curriculum.
- 7 § 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 8 have become a law.
