AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to establishing the offense of forcible touching against a child

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 130.51 to 2 read as follows:
- § 130.51 Forcible touching against a child.

- A person is guilty of forcible touching against a child when such person intentionally and for no legitimate purpose, forcibly touches:
- 1. the sexual or other intimate parts of a child for the purpose of degrading or abusing such child; or for the purpose of gratifying the actor's sexual desire, and the victim is less than thirteen years old; 9 <u>or</u>
- 2. any part of a child for the purpose of gratifying the actor's sexu-10 11 al desire, and the victim is less than thirteen years old.
- 12 For the purposes of this section, forcible touching includes, but is 13 not limited to squeezing, grabbing or pinching.
- Forcible touching against a child is a class E felony. 14
- 15 § 2. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeeding the date on which it shall have become a law.
