AN ACT to amend the agriculture and markets law, in relation to the beginning farmer revolving loan fund program

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 328 of the agriculture and markets law is amended by adding a new subdivision 5 to read as follows:

- 5. "Beginning farmer" shall mean a farmer who has not produced an "agricultural product" as defined in this section, for more than ten consecutive years, and who will materially and substantially participate in the production of an agricultural product within a region of the state.
- 8 § 2. The agriculture and markets law is amended by adding a new 9 section 330-a to read as follows:
- 10 § 330-a. Beginning farmer revolving loan program. 1. The commissioner 11 shall establish and maintain a beginning farmer revolving loan program 12 to provide low interest loans to beginning farmers for the purposes of 13 supporting beginning farmers, encouraging the growth of small agribusiness, preserving farmland as a working agricultural landscape, and 14 providing open space benefits for all residents of the state. Properly 15 16 managed farmland has been demonstrated to be the best environmental 17 usage of land for watershed protection, so it is in the best interest of 18 the state to maintain agricultural land. Such program shall, from any appropriation made available for this purpose, provide low interest 19
- 20 <u>loans to beginning farmers as the commissioner shall deem to be eligible</u>
  21 <u>pursuant to rule or regulation.</u>

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2. The commissioner shall promulgate rules and regulations for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this section, including establishing:

- 4 <u>a. an application process whereby beginning farmers may apply for</u> 5 loans:
- 6 <u>b. criteria and standards for determining a beginning farmer's eligi-</u>
  7 <u>bility for a loan;</u>
- 8 <u>c. criteria and standards for determining the priority to be granted</u> 9 <u>among beginning farmer applicants;</u>
- 10 <u>d. criteria and standards for determining the amount of financial</u>
  11 <u>assistance to be provided to a beginning farmer; and</u>
- e. criteria and standards to be used in determining the loan repayment periods and the terms of any repayment agreement.
- § 3. This act shall take effect on the first of April next succeeding the date on which it shall have become a law; provided, however, that any rules and regulations necessary to implement the provisions of this act on its effective date are authorized to be made on or before such date.
