AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to discontinuing service fees for distinctive license plates issued to veterans

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 3 of section 404-h of the vehicle and traffic law, as amended by chapter 415 of the laws of 2001 , is amended to read as follows:
3. A distinctive plate issued pursuant to this section shall be issued in the same manner as other number plates upon payment of the regular registration fee prescribed by section four hundred one of this article [provided, however, that an additional one-time serviee oharge of ten dollars shall be oharged for such plate].
$\S 2$. Subdivision 4 of section $404-j$ of the vehicle and traffic law, as amended by chapter 415 of the laws of 2001 , is amended to read as follows:
4. Fee. A special plate and registration issued pursuant to this section shall be issued upon payment of the regular registration fee prescribed by section four hundred one of this article [provided, however, that an additional one-time serviee charge of ten dollars shall be ehaxged for sueh plate].
§ 3. Subdivision 3 of section $404-\mathrm{k}$ of the vehicle and traffic law, as amended by chapter 415 of the laws of 2001 , is amended to read as follows:
3. A distinctive plate issued pursuant to this section shall be issued in the same manner as other number plates upon payment of the regular registration fee prescribed by section four hundred one of this article

§ 4. Subdivision 3 of section 404-v of the vehicle and traffic law, as added by chapter 389 of the laws of 2004 , is amended to read as follows:
3. A distinctive plate issued pursuant to this section shall be issued in the same manner as other number plates upon payment of the regular registration fee prescribed by section four hundred one of this article [, provided, however, that an additional onetime sexviee oharge-of ten dollaxs shall be eharged for such plate. Provided, however, that one year aftex the effeetive date of this seetion funds in the ameunt of five thousand-dollars, or so mueh thereof as may be available, shall be alleeated from oueh funde to the department to-offoet eopto aseeciated with the produetion of ouch lieense plateo].
§ 5. Subdivision 3 of section $404-w$ of the vehicle and traffic law, as added by chapter 105 of the laws of 2005 , is amended to read as follows:
3. A distinctive plate issued pursuant to this section shall be issued in the same manner as other number plates upon payment of the regular registration fee prescribed by section four hundred one of this article [, provided, however, that an additional one-time serviee oharge-of ten dollars shall be oharged for sueh plate].
§ 6. Subdivision 4 of section $404-w$ of the vehicle and traffic law, as added by chapter 493 of the laws of 2005 , is amended to read as follows:
4. A distinctive plate issued pursuant to this section shall be issued in the same manner as other number plates upon payment of the regular registration fee prescribed by section four hundred one of this article [provided, however, that an additional one time serviee charge of ten dollars shall be charged for such plate].
§ 7. Subdivision 1-a of section 404 of the vehicle and traffic law, as added by chapter 103 of the laws of 2016 , is amended to read as follows:
$1-a$. The commissioner may issue special number plates to applicants who are members of veterans organizations in the same manner as other number plates are issued pursuant to this article. Such special number plates shall be issued only upon (a) payment of a one-time service charge of ten dollars in addition to the regular registration fee prescribed by section four hundred one of this article, provided that such service charge shall be waived for any applicant who has been a member of the veterans organization for five or more years, and (b) submission of proof, satisfactory to the commissioner, that the applicant is presently a member of the veterans organization for which such plate is requested. [sueh membership shall be verified annually by the applieant.] Application for such plates shall be made in accordance with regulations promulgated by the commissioner with respect to the issuance of such plates. Provided, however, that nothing contained herein shall be deemed to supersede the provisions of section four hundred four-d, four hundred four-e, four hundred four-h, four hundred four-i, four hundred four-j, four hundred four-k, four hundred four-p or four hundred four-aa of this article.
§ 8. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall have become a law.
