AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to reimbursement methodologies for tuition

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph a of subdivision 4 of section 4405 of the educa-2 tion law, as amended by chapter 53 of the laws of 1990, is amended to read as follows:

a. The commissioner [of education] and the commissioner of social 5 services shall develop reimbursement methodologies for the tuition and maintenance components of approved private schools and special act school districts. The commissioner [of education], in consultation with 8 the appropriate state agencies and departments, shall have responsibility for developing [a] reimbursement [methodologies for 9 10 tuition which shall be based upon appropriate educational standards 11 promulgated pursuant to regulations of the commissioner [of education]. The commissioner of social services, in consultation with appropriate 13 state agencies and departments, shall have responsibility for developing a reimbursement methodology for maintenance, pursuant to section three 15 hundred ninety-eight-a of the social services law and the regulations 16 promulgated thereunder. 17

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
