Introduced by M. of A. ROSENTHAL -- read once and referred to the Committee on Health

AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to adding dysmenorrhea to the list of conditions covered for lawful medical use of marijuana

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subparagraph (i) of paragraph (a) of subdivision 7 of
2 section 3360 of the public health law, as added by chapter 90 of the
3 laws of 2014, is amended to read as follows:
4 (i) having one of the following severe debilitating or life-threaten-
5 ing conditions: cancer, dysmenorrhea, positive status for human immuno-
6 deficiency virus or acquired immune deficiency syndrome, amyotrophic
7 lateral sclerosis, Parkinson's disease, multiple sclerosis, damage to
8 the nervous tissue of the spinal cord with objective neurological indi-
9 cation of intractable spasticity, epilepsy, inflammatory bowel disease,
10 neuropathies, Huntington's disease, or as added by the commissioner; and
11 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately, provided, however, that
12 the amendments to section 3360 of the public health law made by section
13 one of this act shall not affect the repeal of such section and shall be
14 deemed repealed therewith.
