AN ACT relating to establishing a legislative committee on racial equity in the New York state assembly

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. a. There is hereby created the legislative committee on 2 racial equity in the New York state assembly. The committee shall 3 provide a racial equity impact assessment on all legislation that is 4 reported favorably to the assembly. The committee shall solicit input 5 from members of the public, especially those individuals with expertise 6 related to racial equity issues, to aid the committee in its work.

b. The committee shall consist of the assembly majority leader, assembly minority leader, and ten members appointed by the speaker of the assembly who are representative of the racial diversity that exists in New York state. Any vacancies occurring among the members of the committee shall be filled in the manner of the original appointment.

12 c. The committee shall (1) prepare a racial equity impact assessment 13 on all legislation that is reported favorably to the assembly to mini-14 mize unanticipated adverse consequences by utilizing resources that have 15 a: (i) history of expertise and positive outcomes in racial equity; and (ii) a deep understanding of ameliorating disproportionate outcomes and 16 17 unintended costs; (2) hold a hearing on any matter relating to the functions of the committee; (3) identify state policies and actions that, in 18 conjunction with public and private partners and in support of racial 19 20 equity, can work to achieve conditions of such; (4) review and make 21 recommendations to align state statutes, regulations, programs, services 22 and budgetary priorities; (5) search for any interdepartmental gaps, inconsistencies and inefficiencies in the implementation or attainment 23 24 of the state policies and actions; (6) identify any new laws, regu-25 lations, programs, services, and budgetary priorities that are needed to

1 ensure and promote desired conditions of racial equity; (7) serve as an 2 informational resource for the assembly; and (8) perform other activ-3 ities, including public awareness.

4 d. The committee shall have the same powers as other standing or 5 select committees of the legislature.

6 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
