AN ACT to amend the criminal procedure law, in relation to designating uniformed officers of the fire marshal's office of the town of Huntington as peace officers

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 63 of section 2.10 of the criminal procedure 2 law, as amended by chapter 638 of the laws of 2003, is amended to read 3 as follows:

63. Uniformed members of the fire marshal's office in the town of Southampton [and], the town of Riverhead <u>and the town of Huntington</u>, when acting pursuant to their special duties in matters arising under the laws relating to fires, the extinguishment thereof and fire perils; provided, however that nothing in this subdivision shall be deemed to authorize such officer to carry, possess, repair or dispose of a firearm unless the appropriate license therefor has been issued pursuant to section 400.00 of the penal law.

12 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
