AN ACT to amend the tax law, in relation to violations of secrecy provisions of the tax law

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 1825 of the tax law, as amended by section 89 of 2 part A of chapter 59 of the laws of 2014, is amended to read as follows: § 1825. Violation of secrecy provisions of the tax law.--(a) Any 4 person who violates the provisions of subdivision (b) of section twen-5 ty-one, subdivision one of section two hundred two, subdivision eight of section two hundred eleven, subdivision (a) of section three hundred 7 fourteen, subdivision one or two of section four hundred thirty-seven, section four hundred eighty-seven, subdivision one or two of section five hundred fourteen, [subsection (e) of section six hundred ninety-10 seven, subsection (a) of section nine hundred ninety-four, subdivision (a) of section eleven hundred forty-six, section twelve hundred eighty-12 seven, subdivision (a) of section fourteen hundred eighteen, subdivision (a) of section fifteen hundred eighteen, subdivision (a) of section 13 14 fifteen hundred fifty-five of this chapter, and subdivision (e) of 15 section 11-1797 of the administrative code of the city of New York shall 16 be guilty of a misdemeanor.

- 20 § 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 21 have become a law.
