AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to prohibiting the deliberate misrepresentation of the character or fitness of a candidate to hold public office

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 3-106 of the election law, as 2 amended by chapter 8 of the laws of 1978 and redesignated by chapter 9 of the laws of 1978, is amended to read as follows:

- 1. In addition to the powers and duties elsewhere enumerated in this article, the state board of elections, after public hearings, shall adopt a "fair campaign code" setting forth ethical standards of conduct for persons, political parties and committees engaged in election campaigns including, but not limited to, specific prohibitions against 9 practices of political espionage and other political practices involving 10 subversion of the political parties and process and specific prohibi-11 tions against deliberate misrepresentation of the character or fitness 12 of a candidate to hold public office, including the use of a candidate's 13 image, name, or likeness in a manner which is misleading.
- 14 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
