AN ACT to amend the tax law, in relation to enacting "Averyana's law"

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as "Averyana's 2 law".
- § 2. Section 606 of the tax law is amended by adding a new subsection 3 (ccc) to read as follows:
- (ccc) Credit for installation of smoke alarms. Any resident owner of 6 real property as defined in section one hundred two of the real property 7 tax law shall be allowed a credit against the tax otherwise imposed under this article in an amount equal to the cost of purchasing and 9 installing certain smoke alarms which incorporate photoelectric technol-10 ogy, including, but not limited to, photoelectric detectors; dual
- 11 photoelectric/ionization detectors; and photoelectric/carbon monoxide
- 12 <u>detectors in his or her residence.</u>
- § 3. This act shall take effect immediately and shall apply to taxable 13 14 years beginning on or after January 1, 2017.
