AN ACT to amend the criminal procedure law, in relation to evidence  
containing deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA)

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assem-  
bly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The criminal procedure law is amended by adding a new  
2 section 60.77 to read as follows:

3 § 60.77 Rules of evidence; deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA).

4 In any prosecution where the court determines that there is relevant  
5 admissible evidence containing deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA), such  
6 evidence shall be admitted.

7 § 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall  
8 have become a law.
