AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to assault on caseworkers

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 11 of section 120.05 of the penal law, as separately amended by chapters 268 and 281 of the laws of 2016, is amended  
2 to read as follows:

4 11. With intent to cause physical injury to a train operator, ticket  
5 inspector, conductor, signalperson, bus operator, station agent, station  
6 cleaner or terminal cleaner employed by any transit agency, authority or  
7 company, public or private, whose operation is authorized by New York  
8 state or any of its political subdivisions, a city marshal, a school  
9 crossing guard appointed pursuant to section two hundred eight-a of the  
10 general municipal law, a traffic enforcement officer, traffic enforcement  
11 agent, prosecutor as defined in subdivision thirty-one of section  
12 1.20 of the criminal procedure law, sanitation enforcement agent, New  
13 York city sanitation worker, public health sanitarian, New York city  
14 public health sanitarian, registered nurse, licensed practical nurse,  
15 emergency medical service paramedic, or emergency medical service technician, he or she causes physical injury to such train operator, ticket  
16 inspector, conductor, signalperson, bus operator, station agent, station  
17 cleaner or terminal cleaner, city marshal, school crossing guard  
18 appointed pursuant to section two hundred eight-a of the general municipal law, traffic enforcement officer, traffic enforcement agent, prosecutor as defined in subdivision thirty-one of section 1.20 of the criminal procedure law, registered nurse, licensed practical nurse, public  
19 health sanitarian, New York city public health sanitarian, sanitation  
20 enforcement agent, New York city sanitation worker, emergency medical  
21 service paramedic, or emergency medical service technician, while such  
22 employee is performing an assigned duty on, or directly related to, the
