Introduced by M. of A. VANEL -- read once and referred to the Committee on Election Law

AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to requiring at least one form of electronic means to verify voter registration at every polling place

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 8-302 of the election law is
2 amended and a new subdivision 1-a is added to read as follows:

3 1-a. At all elections held pursuant to the provisions of this chapter,
4 at least one form of electronic verification of voter registration shall
5 be utilized.

6 2. The voter shall give his name and his residence address to the
7 inspectors. An inspector shall then loudly and distinctly announce the
8 name and residence of the voter and verify such through the electronic
9 means required under subdivision one-a of this section.

10 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
