AN ACT to amend the military law, in relation to pay and allowances of members of the militia

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 210 of the military law, as 2 amended by chapter 418 of the laws of 2004, is amended to read as 3 follows:
- 1. Each member of the militia ordered into the active service of the state pursuant to sections six and seven of this chapter, shall receive for each day or part thereof of such duty the same pay and allowances as are received by members of the appropriate force of the armed forces of the United States of corresponding grade, rating and length of service, or [one hundred twenty five] two hundred fifty dollars per day, whichever is greater.
- 11 § 2. This act shall take effect April 1, 2019.
