AN ACT to enact "Michelle and Jordan's law"; and to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to speed contests and races

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Short title. This act shall be known and may be cited as "Michelle and Jordan's law".

- § 2. Subdivision 2 of section 1182 of the vehicle and traffic law, as amended by section 9 of part C of chapter 62 of the laws of 2003, is amended to read as follows:
- 2. A second conviction within twelve months of a violation of this section shall constitute a class E felony and shall be punishable by imprisonment of [not more than six months] up to one year and one day or a fine of not less than five hundred twenty-five dollars nor more than 10 seven hundred fifty dollars, or both such fine and imprisonment.

§ 3. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after 12 it shall have become a law. Effective immediately the commissioner of 13 motor vehicles may add, amend, or repeal any rule or regulation neces-14 sary for the timely implementation of this act on its effective date.
