AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to establishing the New York State Trooper Timothy Pratt Turnaround

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 344-f to 2 read as follows:

§ 344-f. Portion of state highway system to be designated as the "New 4 York State Trooper Timothy Pratt Turnaround". All that portion of the 5 state highway system in the county of Saratoga constituting the turn-6 around at mile-marker 38.8 on interstate route eighty-seven shall be designated and known as the "New York State Trooper Timothy Pratt Turnaround".

§ 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the instal-10 lation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system 11 as designated pursuant to section one of this act. However, to avoid 12 confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the desig-13 nation called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be one of 14 ceremonial nature and the official name of such highway shall not be 15 changed as a result of this act.

§ 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
