AN ACT to amend the penal law and the criminal procedure law, in relation to promoting sexual performances by a child

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The closing paragraph of section 263.10 of the penal law, 2 as amended by chapter 1 of the laws of 2000, is amended to read as 3 follows:
- 4 Promoting an obscene sexual performance by a child is a class $[\mbox{\ensuremath{D}}]$ $\mbox{\ensuremath{\underline{B}}}$ 5 felony.
- 6 § 2. The closing paragraph of section 263.15 of the penal law, as 7 amended by chapter 1 of the laws of 2000, is amended to read as follows: 8 Promoting a sexual performance by a child is a class [] B felony.
- 9 § 3. Subdivision 5 of section 220.10 of the criminal procedure law is 10 amended by adding a new paragraph (i) to read as follows:
- 11 (i) Where the indictment charges the class B felony offense of promot-12 ing an obscene sexual performance by a child as defined in section 13 263.10 of the penal law or promoting a sexual performance by a child as
- 13 <u>263.10</u> of the penal law or promoting a sexual performance by a child as 14 <u>defined in section 263.15</u> of the penal law, then a plea of guilty must
- 15 include at least a plea to such offense.
- 16 § 4. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeed-17 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
