AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to criminal trespass and burglary upon the premises of a pharmacy

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 140.00 of the penal law is amended by adding a new subdivision 6 to read as follows:

- 6. "Pharmacy" means that area within a building at which the practice of the profession of pharmacy is conducted pursuant to article one hundred thirty-seven of the education law.
- 6 § 2. Subdivision 1 of section 140.15 of the penal law, as amended by 7 chapter 315 of the laws of 2010, is amended to read as follows:
- 8 1. he or she knowingly enters or remains unlawfully in a dwelling or a 9 pharmacy; or
- 10 § 3. Subdivision 2 of section 140.25 of the penal law, as amended by 11 chapter 361 of the laws of 1981, is amended to read as follows:
- 12 2. The building is a dwelling, or the portion of the building that is 13 a pharmacy.
- 14 § 4. The opening paragraph of section 140.30 of the penal law, as 15 amended by chapter 361 of the laws of 1981, is amended to read as 16 follows:
- A person is guilty of burglary in the first degree when he <u>or she</u>
 knowingly enters or remains unlawfully in a dwelling <u>or a pharmacy</u> with
 intent to commit a crime therein, and when, in effecting entry or while
 in the dwelling or in immediate flight therefrom, he <u>or she</u> or another

§ 5. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeeding the date on which it shall have become a law.
