AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to the creation of a study by the commissioner of the office of children and family services regarding staffing levels

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Section 500 of the executive law is amended by adding a new 2 subdivision 2-a to read as follows:
- 3 <u>2-a. The commissioner shall conduct an annual study of facilities</u> 4 <u>operated by the office of children and family services.</u>
- (a) Such study shall include (i) the ratio of non-administrative staff to residents; (ii) the total number of employees compared to the number of employees who were on workers' compensation leave; (iii) the number of staff involved in any reported incident involving the alleged misconduct of a resident, including the title of such staff; and (iv) any other information the commissioner deems relevant.

- 13 services, the commissioner shall submit a report to the legislature no
