AN ACT to amend the village law and the public officers law, in relation to residency requirements for clerk-treasurer or deputy clerk in the village of Fair Haven

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 3-300 of the village law is amended by adding a 2 new subdivision 27 to read as follows:
 - 27. Notwithstanding any provisions of this chapter or any other general law, local law, ordinance or special act, the village board of trustees of the incorporated village of Fair Haven, Cayuga county, may, by resolution, provide that the office of village clerk-treasurer or deputy clerk of such village may be held by a person who is not a resident of such village, provided that such person resides in the county of Cayuga or in an adjoining county within the state of New York.
- 10 § 2. Section 3 of the public officers law is amended by adding a new 11 subdivision 66 to read as follows:
- 12 <u>66. In the village of Fair Haven, Cayuga county, the provisions of</u> 13 <u>this section requiring a person to be a resident of the political subdi-</u>
- 14 vision or municipal corporation of the state for which he or she shall
- 15 be chosen or within which his or her official functions are required to
- 16 be exercised, shall not prevent a person from holding the office of
- 17 village clerk-treasurer or deputy clerk of the village of Fair Haven,
- 18 provided that such person resides in the county in which such village is
- 19 located or an adjoining county within the state of New York. Provided,
- 20 however, the person performing the functions of village clerk-treasurer
- 21 or deputy clerk in any other village shall be a resident of such
- 22 <u>village</u>, <u>unless otherwise provided by law</u>.
